CPAT

All candidate firefighters for Brazos County Precinct 4 must take a Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT). This test was created to test the physical abilities and limits of candidates aspiring to be a firefighter for Brazos County Precinct 4. The obstacles in this course pertain mostly to obstacles firefighters encounter on a daily bases. If the candidate fails to complete an obstacle or dose not finish all obstacles in the time provided the candidate will fail the course. The candidate will have multiple attempts to complete the timed course but will not be voted in as a member of Brazos County Precinct 4. The attempts of the candidate will be noted and documented. The candidate will perform this test twice. The first time will be before the candidate is voted in and the second will be after (Please note that the second time will be slightly shorter the before).This will motivate the new member of Brazos County Precinct 4 to be physically fit and able to perform the same tasks in this course in the field.

The candidate will set their time and date with the coordinator and show up prepared to run the course. They will be dressed in t-shirt, shorts, and tennis shoes. The course will require the candidate to wear a structural firefighting jacket, helmet, gloves, and an air pack (No face mask).
