1. This packet and process can be completed at any point after you are voted in as a firefighter. To be completed in this order. Somewhat
 2. Complete Firefighter 1 and Firefighter 2 On-Line classes as assigned in "Target Solutions" program.
 - a. You will be provided a log in ID and PIN along with instructions
 - b. Target time for this section is within the first 2 months of joining
 3. With each training assignment in target solutions is an associated skill. After you finish the lecture series of a particular segment, print that skill off. Work with your assigned station Lt and assigned station instructors to complete those hands on skills training portion.
 4. Included in target solutions are various other classes required for firefighter 1 and firefighter 2 certification including but not limited to Hazardous materials.
 5. You must attend and complete live fire training at fire school or an area school to be eligible for firefighter 1 and firefighter 2 certification. This can only be done AFTER you have finished the entire lecture and skills training identified in item #2 and #3.

 10. Complete Emergency Driving series of training in target solutions.
 11. Complete firefighter written exam (on line)
 12. Complete JPST (physical performance test) working with your Station Lt to set up date.
 13. Get you DSHS ECA certification
 14. Get your Sffma Wildland certification
- **All the above is the minimum required training for all firefighters to be completely timely upon joining****
